- 1) The **headquarters** of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) was in **Atlanta**, Georgia.
- 2) SCLC was established by the **Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr.** and other civil rights activists in **1957**.
- 3) They coordinated and assisted local organizations who were working for the full **equality** of African Americans in all aspects of **American** life.
- 4) The organization operated primarily in the **South** and some border states.
- 5) The SCLC played a major part in the civil rights **March** on Washington, D.C., in **1963** and in the voter-registration efforts in Georgia, and Alabama.
- 6) After King was **assassinated** in April 1968, his place as president was taken by the Reverend Ralph David **Abernathy**.
- 7) The SCLC maintained its philosophy of nonviolent **social change**.
