Instructions: Complete the Guided Notes for the Britannica SCLC Research Article.

- 1) The **headquarters** of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) was in **Atlanta**, Georgia.
- 2) SCLC was established by the <u>Reverend Martin Luther King</u>, <u>Jr.</u> and other civil rights activists in 1957.
- 3) They coordinated and assisted local organizations who were working for the full **equality** of <u>African Americans</u> in all aspects of <u>American</u> life.
- 4) The organization operated primarily in the <u>South</u> and some border states.
- 5) The SCLC played a major part in the <u>civil rights</u> <u>March on Washington</u>. <u>D.C.</u>, in 1963 and in the voter-registration efforts in Georgia, and Alabama.
- 6) After King was **assassinated** in April 1968, his place as <u>president</u> was taken by the <u>Reverend Ralph David **Abernathy**</u>.
- 7) The SCLC maintained its philosophy of nonviolent **social change**.
