- 1) Who was arrested in December 1955? **Rosa Parks**
- 2) What did she refuse to do? **Give up her seat to a white person**
- 3) The boycott was against the segregated **bus** system.
- 4) The boycott lasted more than a **year**.
- 5) Who was the spokesperson for the Montgomery Bus Boycott?
Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
- 6) On February 21, 1956, leaders of the boycott and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. were **arrested**.
- 7) Dr. King was prosecuted, convicted, fined \$**1000**, and given one year of **jail** time with hard labor.
- 8) The homes of several leaders, including Dr. King, were **bombed**.
- 9) Organizers filed a **federal** lawsuit challenging the constitutionality.
- 10) On November 13, 1956, the **Supreme** Court ruled that public bus segregation was unconstitutional.
- 11) On December 21, **1956**, the Montgomery Bus Boycott ended.
