- 1) Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee was founded in April 1960.
- 2) Formed in an effort to bring together all the **young** people who served in the **sit-ins** over the years.
- 3) The students accepted **nonviolence** as a way of life.
- 4) It was the job of SNCC to facilitate the students and coordinate events.
- 5) It was very hard for people of color to register to vote.
- 6) The **Student Voice** was a newspaper printed by SNCC in Atlanta, Georgia.

- 7) John Lewis became the third chairman of SNCC in May of 1963.
