


Unit 1: Injustice and Inequality Activities Choice Board

<p><i>Martin's Big Words: The Life of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.</i> By Doreen Rappaport</p>  <p>Discuss the characters, plot, feelings, vocabulary, summary, and themes.</p>	<p>Listen to Dr. King's Fun Town Speech Excerpt at Zion Hill / YouTube Audio</p> <p>Have the students look at the flashback images of Fun Town Amusement Park.</p> <p>Discussion questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Which amusement park do you want to visit? * What if you were told you could not go to that park because of how you look? * How do you think Dr. King's daughter felt when she was told she could not go to Fun Town because of her skin color? * How does "fair" and "equal" relate to this?

<p>Discussion: Read and Discuss the Young MLK Injustice and Inequity Facts (K-2)</p> <p>Use the Emoji Cards to react to the facts: <i>How do you think Martin felt?</i></p> <p>Large Group Discussion: <i>What would make it fair? What would make things better?</i></p>	<p>Discussion: Read and Discuss the Young MLK Injustice and Inequity Facts (3-5)</p> <p>Small Group/Individual Work: Complete the Reflection of Injustice and Inequality Worksheet</p> <p>Large Group Discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Review the vocabulary terms and student reflections. * Discussion Questions: <i>What would make it fair? What would make things better? Is it possible to live in a world where people are not judged by the color of their skin but by the content (quality) of their character (who they are as a person)?</i> <p>Acknowledge the themes among students' answers.</p>
