# **Purpose of the Guide**

This guide is designed to help organizations across the nation coordinate donation drives and assemble care kits, including hygiene kits, to support those in need. The goal is to drop off completed care kits at The King Center by January 20th.

# **Project Overview**

The MLK Day of Service Community Project aims to gather and distribute essential care kits to underserved individuals and families in the Atlanta area. This includes hygiene kits containing personal care items to ensure dignity and wellness for those in need.

# **Project Mission**

As part of the MLK Day of Service initiative, our mission is to honor Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s legacy of community service. By assembling care kits filled with essential hygiene products, we aim to raise awareness on issues in the community and provide dignity and support to individuals and families facing hardships. Our goal is to inspire collective action and foster a spirit of compassion, ensuring that everyone in our community has access to necessities and the resources they need to thrive.

# **Suggested Supplies List for General Care Kits**

- Shampoo and conditioner
- Soap and body wash
- Toothpaste and toothbrushes
- Deodorant
- Feminine hygiene products
- Razors and shaving cream
- Hand sanitizer
- Lotion
- Facial tissues
- Combs or brushes

### Where to Order

The supplies can be ordered from local stores like Walmart, CVS, or big-box retailers like Costco. Online retailers such as Amazon may also offer bulk purchasing options.

For organizations seeking bulk orders, consider reaching out directly to manufacturers for potential discounts or working with local wholesalers. We recommend <u>Spark Branded Solutions</u>. # **Activation Timeline**

### **Planning Phase**

- Set a budget and target number of care kits to assemble.
- Identify partner organizations and recruit volunteers.
- Establish a budget and allocate funds for supplies.
- Select necessary hygiene items and order supplies.

### **Preparation Phase**

- Arrange logistics for transportation and delivery of supplies.
- Recruit volunteers and assign roles for assembly day.
- Promote the project through social media, email, newsletters, and community outreach.

### **Execution Phase (Event Day)**

- Set up assembly stations for packing care kits with signs.
- Coordinate volunteers to efficiently assemble and pack kits.
- Organize distribution logistics for delivering kits to The King Center.
- Thank your volunteers for their hard work!

## Follow-up Phase (Post-Event)

- Complete the Impact Tracker for your project.
- Conduct a debriefing session to assess the project's success.
- Express gratitude to volunteers, sponsors, and partner organizations.
- Collect feedback from recipients to measure impact.

# **Additional Tips**

- Consider hosting a kickoff event to raise awareness and excitement.
- Collaborate with local businesses for sponsorships or in-kind donations.
- Engage volunteers from diverse backgrounds to enhance community involvement.
- Document the project with photos and testimonials to showcase impact.
